Breckenridge Youth Program Twin Town Baseball League (TTBL) is for all 9, 10, 11 and 12 year olds. This will be the only league option for Breckenridge/Wahpeton for these ages.

Majors (11 & 12 year olds) Wednesday, May 3rd 7:00-8:30 pm Wahpeton Community Center

Cost: \$45.00 per player and includes a team hat, t-shirt and mandated Babe Ruth League insurance. Players will need to provide baseball pants, cleats (no metal spikes allowed) and a baseball glove.

Registration deadline April 30th. After April 30th the cost will be \$70.00 per player.

Early registration allows for planning purposes & smaller teams.

There is no guarantee that you will be placed on a team if you register after April 30th.
